



A Description of the New England Colony ISBN #9780998092317 [Light Brown] Based on the title page from John Smith's account of the first permanent colony in America in the year 1614, including their significant trials and tribulations. 4. The Journal of Major George Washington With the proofe of the prejent benefit this

ISBN #9780998092348 [Dark Brown] From George Washington's journal as a young Major sent by the Brittish to petition and warn the French forces to leave the Ohio country. The French and Indian War soon followed this daring expedition. First published in 1754, the work made Washington well-known throughout the colonies.




5. Journal of Sir Joseph Banks

6. A Journal of Captain Cook's Last Voyage **ISBN #9780998092324** [Light Grey]










Smooth, soft simulated vegetable tanned Leather covers, deep embossed



Nicholai Copernicus' classical work first published after his death because of the heretical nature of his astronomical observations, here from the 1618 printing in Amsterdam.

ISBN #9780998092379 [Pitti Dark Brown] From Galileo's famous "Dialogo", the work that got him in trouble with the Catholic Church, and almost caused his excommunication and death. From the Florence, Italy printing of 1622.
